The Great Light is one of the largest lighthouse optics ever built, and is around 130 years old. It used to be on one of the Copeland Islands between 1924 and 2014, and that is why our P6 and P7 pupils have been invited to attend the official opening of the Great Light visitor attraction at Titanic Belfast on Thursday, March 8.

P6/7 pupils should be in full school uniform and will be collected at 9am for the ceremony at 11am; we will then walk to the HMS Caroline for snacks (pupils should also bring a packed lunch) and will be brought back to school around 1.30pm.
