General Information

Uniform: Full school uniform must be worn.

For Miss McNamee's class this is a white polo shirt, school sweater and grey trousers / skirt.

For pupils in P3 to P7, pupils should wear white shirt, school tie and sweater, and grey trousers (or shorts) / skirt.

(In term 3, all girls also have the option to replace their skirt, shirt and tie with their summer dress).

Black school shoes must be worn by all pupils including with summer dresses. Sports shoes / trainers can only be worn on PE days (or for sports-related after-school clubs).

PE track bottoms should only be plain navy. As of May 1st, Carol in Buywell (D'dee) has these in stock.

School starts at 9am. Please note that, unless children are at Breakfast Club, all pupils should not arrive before 8.45am.

Cars & taxis. Please do not drive into the school grounds & please do not park in front of the gate which allows access for staff, visitors and emergency services; this gate must be kept clear at all times.

Smoking, including the use of e-cigarettes, is not allowed on the school grounds.

Dogs. Dogs must not be brought on to school grounds; please keep dogs at the school gates and on their lead at all times.
