

I would like to take this opportunity to thank you for your support throughout the past 10 months. You have helped the school in so many ways and, in doing so, have helped support your child's education.

A copy of your child's school report for 2018/19 is enclosed for you to share with your child, congratulate them on their achievements and possibly help them identify areas to focus on next year.

The 2019/2020 school year will be organised as follows:

Reception, P1& P2	Miss McNamee
P3 & P4	Mrs Adams (Mon to Thurs) & Mr Hennessy (Fri)
P5, P6 & P7	Mr Hennessy (Mon ~ Wed) & Mrs Fitzsimons (Thurs & Fri)

First day back for P1 to P7 will be Tuesday August 27.

Reception Class will finish at 10.20 until Friday, Sept 20. And then at 11.45 from Sept 23 onwards. **P1** will finish at 12 noon for until Friday Sept 20. From Monday September 23, P1 finish at 1.45pm. **P2 & P3 children will finish at 1.45 from August 27 onwards.**

For **P4 to P7** children, school will finish at 1.45pm for the first four days (Aug. $27 \sim 30$).

Please note the Friday finish time for $\underline{P4}$ children: they will finish early (1.45pm) every Friday to allow for staff planning and preparation. From Monday to Thursday they will finish at 3pm.

Break will be provided free of charge for all pupils for the first 4 days, and can be ordered by Aug 30 for the rest of September (£4.20). Milk will be available from Monday September 9 (£3.40 for milk assuming that the price of milk remains at 21p; this is normally rounded up/down each month to allow for easier admin). If parents wish to order break and milk for September, they should pay at the office before Friday, August 30

School dinners will be available from Monday, September 2 for P2 to P7s, and can be ordered on the first day back (pack lunches should be brought by all P2s to P7s for Aug. 27, 28, 29 & 30). The price of school meals should still be £2.60 per day from September 3 (tbc). As in previous years, any meals for the week must be ordered and paid for on Mondays only. Please check your eligibility for Free School Meals (www.eani.org) and apply as early as possible even if your child does not want to take school dinners (it is very beneficial for the school).

All pupils should have their own sports-top water bottle and, in a small pencil case, some basic stationery: <u>HB pencils, sharpener, eraser, colouring pencils, and a glue stick (which will need replacing through the year)</u>. Please note: Miss McNamee's class do not need a school bag! P5 to P7 pupils should also have a 30cm ruler and a dictionary.

The school office will be open from August 20 should you have any questions.
